SATs Results

This was the second year of the new Year 6 testing arrangements and was based on the 2014 National Curriculum and this resulted in changes to the marks with scaled scores being used and a score of 100 being the mark which was deemed to be 'Secondary Ready'.

This year we had 32 pupils in Year 6, each child was worth 3.1%. The national averages and our school results for 2017 were as follows:

Thank you to all staff involved in the preparation for the assessments. Their dedication and enthusiasm, along with the hard work of the pupils involved, have resulted in some very pleasing results. The pupils leave Highnam having fulfilled their potential and ready for the next stage of their education at the various local secondary schools.

We had a fantastic final few weeks with our Year 6 pupils. There was a Leavers' disco, the traditional BBQ and rounders match, Leavers' Hoodies and a superb Leavers' Service. A big thank you to Miss Read and all the parents who contributed to the enjoyable and memorable end of term celebrations.
